Identifying Historic Assets of Special Local Interest

I am writing to let you know about an interesting project that we are launching early in the New Year:- Identifying Historic Assets of Special Local Interest. You may be aware that the current Conwy Local Development Plan contains a policy named "Buildings and Structures of Local Importance (policy CTH/3)". This policy seeks to offer some protection to locally important buildings and structures that aren't categorised as Listed Buildings. In preparation for the Revised Local Development Plan, we are seeking to formulate a list of such buildings that is ready to hand when planning applications are received. For this, we would be extremely grateful of Town and Community Councils' input, expertise and knowledge of your local areas and readiness to engage with your local communities to put forward nominations to go onto this "local list."

We will be writing to all Conwy Town and Community Councils and Conservation Interest Groups early in the New Year to invite nominations of such buildings and structures. We will provide some criteria via an online web-form so you can assess any nominations and then submit them to us over the internet (paper forms will also be available if preferred.) For this exercise to run as smoothly as possible, and to capture input from local residents, we envisage that members of the public will channel nominations via their local Town or Community Council.

As some Town and Community Councils have areas that partly fall within the Eryri National Park, we will only be asking these Councils for nominations of buildings and structures that are situated within the Conwy local planning authority area (outside the National Park boundary).

I hope this sounds like a sensible and workable approach. In terms of time frames we will be allowing around three months to receive your nominations from the date our letter is emailed out to you (this will be in January). However if you have any problems, queries or concerns please do get in touch to discuss.
