Good morning Hannah

The members at the Town Council meeting on Monday 6/11/2023, resolved that I write to CCBC to enquire if CCBC would consider installing additional bus shelters on Towyn Road.

The members feel that the bus shelters are required, as whilst all proposed locations are existing bus stops, they don't have any cover/protection. They are well used by our visitors and our residents, including school children and the elderly.

The proposed locations are:

- a) Across the road to the existing bus shelter outside Palins Caravan Park (Towyn to Kinmel Bay direction).
- b) Outside Browns Caravan Park (Towyn to Pensarn direction).
- c) Outside Jakes (Pensarn to Towyn direction).

Please can you kindly confirm:-

- 1/ Is this is something which CCBC would consider?
- 2/ Approximately how much would it cost per bus shelter installation (including traffic management)?
- 3/ Who would actually own the bus shelters?
- 4/ I assume that for ongoing cleaning/maintenance/refurbishment purposes, TKBTC would pay CCBC £250 per bus shelter per year, as per the arrangement in place for the existing bus shelters.
