

HAVE YOUR SAY - Play Scheme Improvements - Public Consultation

Tir Prince Park

Conwy County Borough Council is currently reviewing several facilities within the park and has asked the Town Council to carry out a public consultation. This consultation will focus on the current use of the Outdoor Gym Equipment Area and the Skate Park, as well as gathering views on a proposed new Pump Track.

Your feedback will help inform future decisions about investment, upgrades, and how best to use park space.

Outdoor Gym Equipment Area

The outdoor gym equipment is currently limited by the condition of its current surface, which is often water logged. Conwy CBC are considering options for improvement or replacement.
