Just sharing this email trail from Network rail for awareness please among members

Is it something the TC would like to consider as there is no funding source from within CCBC – I am unfamiliar with the area so not sure of issues in area but believe it would be of benefit to have a permanent camera on the beach front as it can be used as a ‘rat run’

The mobile camera at Kinmel Dunes was removed due to the works as ended up just covering the site. Power is always an issue for any proposed new camera – but could be provided by NR perhaps? Costs could be somewhere in region of 2/3k dependant on specification but annual revenue is always the biggest issue as we would seeking the £544pa per camera cost to maintain it going forward.

Let me know if you would like firm costs please?

As you are aware, we recently held public engagement sessions at both Ty Gwyn caravan park and in the Town Hall. One of common themes from the caravan park owners and members of the public was concern about potential ASB on the bridge, with suggestions for the bridge to have lighting and CCTV.

Our current plans for the bridge do not include lighting, however we have taken this feedback on board and will look to include low level lighting in the next stage of design.

Unfortunately, we are not in a position to provide, maintain or monitor CCTV. However, we could install CCTV as part of the project, should there be available funding from elsewhere. Please can you advise whether this is something the council would be able to fund?
