Please can you kindly provide some advice/guidance regarding the following:

The Owain Glyndwr Community Garden was set up following a public consultation.

However, whilst the community fully support the scheme, we have lost a number of volunteers, and we are finding it almost impossible to identify new members of the public who are prepared to volunteer to maintain the garden and/or lock and unlock the gates each day.

We are now down to one volunteer (one of our councillors) he undertakes all the maintenance work in the garden, and he is presently unlocking the gates at 9am and locking them at 9pm each day (7 days a week).

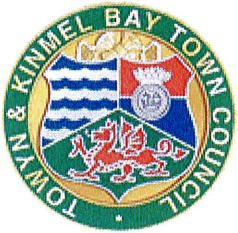
Clearly the garden can't continue in it's present format with only volunteer, and we are looking to come up with alternative options.

One of the options could be to split the site into 2 or 3 allotments and ask interested parties to apply/express their interest.

However, given that the site is a Public Open Space, can access be restricted to 2/3 local residents, or does it have to be fully accessible to the whole community?
