Subject: Extensions to existing schemes

Hi Dylan,

Just to update you regarding the requested proposals for extensions to the current schemes in Towyn and Kinnel Bay along Sandbank Rd and St Asaph Ave respectively. For Sandbank Rd in Towyn to provide coverage from approx the Glan Morfa to Gors Rd (Knightley's Bar) – IT have estimated the total costs to be around £13,640.36. For St Asaph Ave in Kinnel Bay to provide coverage from Bronwen Avenue to the entrance to the beach car park – IT have estimated the total costs would be around £7,846.46.

We are still awaiting final confirmation of our funding for 2025/26 and as such I am unable to say whether or not there is scope for this under the SMART Towns umbrella at this stage. I just wanted you to be aware of the estimated total costs so that you were aware of the costs without factoring in any grant contribution should you wish to go ahead without grant support.

We are looking at the issue of signage separately to the above.
