

Hi Everyone, firstly, I'd like to thank everyone for the responses to Public Consultation regarding the installation of 10 Solar Street Lights on Sandy Cove, I am aware that there are many area's on the estate that are desperately in need of more street lighting, but with a limited budget we are limited to how many we can install at this time, hopefully we will be in a position in the future to install additional Solar Lighting on the estate.

A couple of months ago, I spent my evening going around the whole estate looking for the darkest parts of the streets, as you can imagine, this was quite difficult to choose where the new lighting should go, I made the decision of where the installations should be to give more lighting in their areas, please see street map of proposed installations

With regards to more lighting on the promenade, because the Kinmel Bay Dunes are a Nature Reserve the lighting has to be Dark Sky approved, these are low level and as there are no Solar approved made, they would have to be 240v mains.

As installing mains cable the length of the promenade will be expensive, officers are watching the budget and if sufficient funds are left in may included sometime in the future.
