What it is:

PATRWM is an open data platform developed in Wales. It helps communities, businesses, and visitors understand how places are used.

How it works:

Collects data from sensors and network points.

Shows how busy an area is and information about the local environment.

Why it matters:

Helps Councils and local groups make better decisions about transport, public spaces, and services.

Provides real-time insights that can improve planning and community use.

The reports are available as open-source public data, meaning businesses in your towns could access the data dashboards at any time.

PATRWM gives data-based insights so we can manage our towns and services more effectively.
