Am I correct to assume this is the high point observation deck on the dunes, if so my concerns are access, it is not possible for disabled or poor mobility access so basically it's only fit young people who can get there!

I would like to see a more inclusive and accessible platform. Sea views are nice but this is a rare example of natural biodiversity and you say to be improved. I have been undertaking some biodiversity surveys and realise we need to engage with communities to appreciate and recognise the importance. Currently concerned about the invasive yellow legged hornet, not just from a beekeeping perspective but as a nature depleted country we cannot afford to lose species.
