Annwyl Rhanddeiliaid, Cyd-bwyllgor Corfforedig Gogledd Cymru a'r Cynllun Datblygu Strategol Mae Cyd-bwyllgor Corfforedig y Gogledd (CBC) yn gorff corfforedig rhanbarthol a sefydlwyd i wella lles economaidd drwy ehangu cydweithio a chynllunio strategol ledled Gogledd Cymru. Mae’n dod a chwe Awdurdod Lleol a’r Awdurdod Parc Cenedlaethol Eryri at ei gilydd i ymdrin â blaenoriaethau rhanbarthol allweddol. Mae’r CBC wedi cytuno i fabwysiadu brand Uchelgais Gogledd Cymru. Sefydlwyd Cyd-Bwyllgorau Corfforedig yn dilyn gweithredu Rheoliadau gan Lywodraeth Cymru ym mis Ebrill 2021 ac mae ganddynt ddwy ddyletswydd statudol, sef: • Paratoi Cynllun Datblygu Strategol (SDP) • Paratoi Cynllun Trafnidiaeth Rhanbarthol (RTP) Yn ogystal, mae gan y CBC ddyletswydd anstatudol, i wella a hyrwyddo lles economaidd eu hardal. Ers 2019, mae Uchelgais Gogledd Cymru wedi bod yn cyflawni Cynllun Twf Gogledd Cymru - buddsoddiad o £1 biliwn yn economi'r rhanbarth, ac mae £240m ohono yn cael ei ariannu gan Lywodraeth Cymru a Llywodraeth y DU. Yn awr, gyda'i gyfrifoldebau ychwanegol fel CBC, mae Uchelgais Gogledd Cymru wedi cynhyrchu Cynllun Trafnidiaeth Rhanbarthol sy'n cwmpasu'r cyfnod 2025-30, ac yn y camau olaf am gymeradwyaeth. Mae'r CBC bellach yn dechrau gweithio ar drydedd elfen ei gylch gorchwyl, sef	Dear Stakeholder, North Wales Corporate Joint Committee and the Strategic Development Plan The North Wales Corporate Joint Committee (CJC) is a regional government body established to improve economic well-being through enhanced collaboration and strategic planning across North Wales. It brings together six Local Authorities and the Snowdonia National Park Authority to address key regional priorities. The North Wales Corporate Joint Committee has agreed to adopt the brand of Ambition North Wales. CJCs were established following the implementation of Regulations by Welsh Government in April 2021 and have two statutory duties, to: • Prepare a Strategic Development Plan • Prepare a Regional Transport Plan In addition, CJCs have a non-statutory duty, to enhance and promote the economic well-being of their area. Since 2019 Ambition North Wales has been delivering the North Wales Growth Deal - a £1 billion investment to the region’s economy, £240m of which is funded by the Welsh Government and UK Government. Now, with its added responsibilities as a CJC, Ambition North Wales has produced a Regional Transport Plan covering the period 2025-30, which is in the final stages of approval. The CJC is now beginning work on the third element of its

Y cam cyntaf yn y broses yw i'r CBC baratoi **Cytundeb Cyflawni** ar gyfer y Cynllun Datblygu Strategol. Mae dwy brif ran i hyn: Datganiad o Gyfranogiad Cymunedol sy'n nodi sut bydd y cynllun yn cael ei gynhyrchu a phwy fydd yn cymryd rhan a sut; ac amserlen fanwl sy'n nodi pa mor hir y bydd yn ei gymryd i baratoi'r cynllun, gan ddilyn yr holl gamau a nodir yn rheoliadau a chanllawiau Llywodraeth Cymru.

Mae Llywodraeth Cymru wedi nodi'r mathau o ymgynhorwyr yn y Rheoliadau Cynllun Datblygu Strategol y dylai'r CBC geisio ymgysylltu â hwy, **ac rydych chi a/neu eich sefydliad chi yn un o'r ymgynghorai hynny.** Felly, rwy'n ysgrifennu i ofyn i chi ystyried cymryd rhan yn y broses SDP, sy'n dechrau gyda'r Cytundeb Cyflawni, ac hefyd i ofyn i chi ddarparu'r pwynt cyswllt gorau yn eich sefydliad, os nad yw'r neges e-bost hon eisoes wedi cyrraedd y person hwnnw. Yna, bydd y CBC yn cadw cronfa ddata o gysylltiadau ar gyfer y dyfodol er mwyn rhoi gwybod i chi am y camau allweddol a'r camau nesaf yn y broses.

remit, production of a **Strategic Development Plan (SDP) for North Wales.**

The first stage in this process is for the CJC to prepare a **Delivery Agreement** for the SDP. This has two main parts to it: a Statement of Community Involvement which sets how the plan will be produced and who will be involved and how; and a detailed timetable that sets out how long it will take to prepare the plan, following all of the stages set out in Welsh Government regulations and guidance.

Welsh Government has identified types of consultees in the Strategic Development Plan Regulations who the CJC should attempt to engage with, **and you and/or your organisation is one of those consultees.** I am therefore writing to ask that you consider engaging in the forthcoming SDP process starting with the **Delivery Agreement**, and secondly to ask you to provide the best point of contact within your organisation, if this email has not already reached that person. The CJC will then maintain a contacts database going forward to give you notice of key stages and next steps in the process.
