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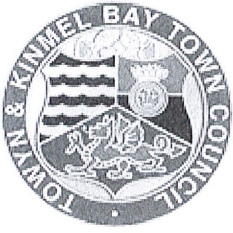

Good morning Ifan

1/ With reference to my email of 23/1/2026 (copy below) and our subsequent telephone call, I notice that the Speed Sensing Sign on St Asaph Avenue is still not working.

When you rang me in late January/early February, you indicated that you had asked one of your team members to remove the faulty sign, and that you were in contact with a company who may be able to repair the existing sign, as it's only just over twelve months old.

Have there been any developments in this regard?

Unfortunately, the company has gone into administration therefore we will not be able to repair the sign. If you wish to replace the sign, we will need to seek an alternative manufacturer. An engineer has been out today and discovered that there is a power issue, we will investigate and hopefully we will be able to restore operation of the sign.

2/ Now that the speed limit is changing (back to 30mph from 20mph) on part of St Asaph Avenue, will this affect the location and requirement of the existing speed sensing signs on St Asaph Avenue?

We will need advice from our traffic department on this.

3/ The members are also proposing to request that Conwy CBC Street Lighting consider installing an additional speed sensing signs near/outside the Jumping Jacks Nursey on St Asaph Avenue, as vehicles speed up before they enter the national speed limit section of St Asaph Avenue, with the town council covering the cost of the proposed sign, and a sign post if one is required.

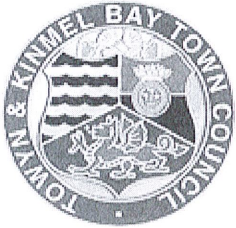
Could this proposed sign be a solar powered sign, which would reduce the carbon footprint, reduce the installation costs and avoid having to add to Conwy CBC's unmetered supply inventory.

Happy to discuss options here.

We have a full town council meeting in mid April, and I would be extremely grateful if you could provide an update/respond to the three above points/questions by say 10/04/2026.

Good afternoon Ifan

I trust that you and your family are well, and that you had a good Xmas & New Year.

I understand that you have been speaking to Cllr Nigel regarding a replacement Speed Sensing Sign on St Asaph (please refer to the below email chain).

I gather that whilst the existing sign (paid for by TKBTC) was only purchased and installed by CCBC in late 2024, unfortunately it has not been possible for CCBC to claim on the warranty as the company that supplied the sign to CCBC has gone into receivership.

I believe that the members of TKBTC would look favourable on possibly covering the cost of purchasing and fitting a replacement sign, however I don't believe that the members would be happy to cover the cost of the energy. Surely CCBC must already have a speed sign at this location on their unmetered supply records/return.

If TKBTC do agree to purchase and install, please can you kindly confirm :-

- If CCBC's have a required specification for speed sensing signs.

- Do CCBC collect data from their speed signs, and if so what do they do with the data/ use the data for.
- Exactly what papers/documentation you would require from our contractor.
- If TKBC decided to go down the route of a solar replacement sign, would CCBC agree to disconnect/remove their existing sign from the post free of charge?
