Prynhawn Da / Good Afternoon,

Mae Bwrdd Gwasanaeth Cyhoeddus (BGC) Conwy a Sir Ddinbych yn falch o gyhoeddi bod y Cynllun Llesiant Lleol (2023 – 2028) bellach wedi'i gymeradwyo yn swyddogol.

Mae'n ganlyniad y gwaith a ddechreuwyd yn 2021 ac mae'n cynrychioli ein casgliadau ar yr hyn rydym yn teimlo yw'r prif faes sy'n cyflwyno'r angen neu'r her fwyaf i'n cymunedau. Mae'n ble rydym yn teimlo y gall y BGC wneud y cyfraniad mwyaf heb ddyblygu gwaith da sydd eisoes yn digwydd o fewn partneriaethau a sefydliadau presennol.

Byddwn yn canolbwyntio ar **gwneud Conwy a Sir Ddinbych yn lle mwy cyfartal gyda llai o amddifadedd**. Rydym hefyd wedi nodi 4 prif thema ar gyfer cefnogi'r prif nod, gan gynnwys –

- **Lles** – Mae cymunedau'n hapusach, yn fwy iach ac yn fwy gwydn i wynebu heriau, megis yr Argyfwng Newid Hinsawdd a Natur, neu'r cynnydd mewn costau byw.
- **Economi** – Mae yna economi ffyniannus, a gefnogir gan weithlu medrus sy'n barod at y dyfodol.
- **Cydraddoldeb** – Mae'r rhai â nodweddion a ddiogelir yn wynebu llai o rwystrau.
- **Tai** – Mae gwell mynediad at dai o ansawdd da.

Er bod llawer o waith wedi'i wneud yn barod i gyrraedd y pwynt yma, dim ond dechrau taith y BGC yw hwn. Mae'r cynllun hwn yn amlinellu beth yr hoffem ei gyflawni, ond mae mwy o waith i'w wneud i ddatblygu ein rhaglen waith.

The Conwy and Denbighshire Public Services Board (PSB) are pleased to announce that the Local Well-being Plan (2023 – 2028) has recently been approved.

The publication of the Local Well-being Plan is the culmination of work that began in 2021, and represents our findings on what our assessment of well-being has identified as areas that pose key opportunities for collaborative working. This is where we feel the PSB can make the greatest contribution without duplicating good work already taking place within existing partnerships and organisations.

We will focus on **making Conwy and Denbighshire a more equal place with less deprivation**. We have also identified 4 key themes to support our main objective, these include:

- **Well-being** – Communities are happier, healthier and more resilient in the face of challenges, such as the Climate Change and Nature Emergency, or the rising cost of living.
- **Economy** – There is a flourishing economy, supported by a skilled workforce fit for the future.
- **Equality** – Those with protected characteristics face fewer barriers.
- **Housing** – There is improved access to good quality housing.
