
Mona Offshore Wind Project: consultation to run from 19 April to 4 June 2023

I am writing to inform you that from 19 April to 4 June 2023, Mona Offshore Wind Limited (a joint venture of bp Alternative Energy Investments Ltd and Energie Baden-Württemberg AG) (the “Applicant”) is holding a statutory consultation on plans for its Mona Offshore Wind Project (the “Project”). This consultation relates to a proposed application to the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero under the Planning Act 2008 for a development consent order (DCO) for the Project.

The Project is a proposed offshore wind farm located in the east Irish Sea. The wind farm is expected to comprise up to 107 wind turbine generators and associated offshore and onshore infrastructure to connect the wind turbine generators to each other and to the national grid. The Project is expected to have an installed capacity of approximately 1.5 gigawatts (GW) and will be located approximately 28km from the Anglesey coastline, approximately 39km from the north west coast of England, and approximately 42km from the Isle of Man. The Project will help deliver a significant amount of offshore wind in support of the UK Government’s Net Zero by 2050 target and commitment to deliver up to 50 GW of offshore wind by 2030.

Wind turbine generators and offshore substation platforms will be located within the offshore wind farm site. The wind turbine generators and offshore substation platforms will be connected to each other via interarray and interconnector cables and will be fixed to the seabed with foundation structures.

The electricity generated by the wind turbine generators will be transported to the national grid via underground offshore and onshore cables. The cables will

make landfall to the west of Pensarn and east of Llanddulas in Conwy and connect the Project to the existing National Grid substation at Bodelwyddan, Denbighshire via the Project's onshore substation.
