- **UK Shared Prosperity Fund – replace EU funds**
- **To Build Pride in Place and increasing life chances**
- **£2.6bn funding available across the UK**
- **UK Government allocation - predominantly revenue funding**
- **Programme April 2022 – March 2025**

UK SHARED PROSPERITY FUND

- **Conditional allocation – to access, each place asked to set out prioritised interventions and measurable outcomes in an Investment Plan – submitted in August 2022**
- **UK and Welsh Governments keen to promote regional working using existing City and Growth Deal areas, and Local Authorities for each region in Wales invited to collaborate in developing a Regional Investment Plan to deliver the fund**
- **A Lead Authority needed to be identified to accept and manage the regional allocation – Gwynedd CC**
- **Gwynedd CC coordinated and submitted the Investment Plan with input from each Local Authority in North Wales**

CRONFA FFYNIANT GYFFREDIN Y DU UK SHARED PROSPERITY FUND

Cynllun Buddsoddi Rhanbarthol / Regional Investment Plan

A hybrid delivery model, combining some local, sub-regional / multi county and regional interventions reflecting wider existing and emerging investments

- **Local (single local authority) complementing investments from other funding sources for similar activity, e.g. WG Regeneration Funding streams**
- **Sub-regional and some regional (multi local authority) projects**

- Improvements to town centres and high streets
- New or existing community and neighbourhood infrastructure projects
- Creation and improvement of local green spaces
- Enhanced support for existing cultural, historic and heritage institutions
- Design and management of the built and landscaped environment
- Support for local arts, cultural, heritage and creative activities
- Active travel enhancements and other small scale green transport projects
- Campaigns to encourage visiting and exploring the local area
- Impactful volunteering and/or social action projects
- Funding for local sports facilities, teams and leagues
- Capacity building and infrastructure to support local groups
- Community engagement schemes – local regeneration
- Community measures to reduce the cost of living
- Relevant feasibility studies
- Investment and support for digital infrastructure for local facilities

Proses ymgeisio / Application process

- Two Stage application process across North Wales
- First Stage application deadline **noon Friday 24th February 2023**
- Assessment during March 2023
- Invitation to Stage 2 anticipated April 2023
- Stage 2 timescale no submission deadline
- Project approvals April 2023 onwards
- Funding award letters issued by Lead Authority (Gwynedd CC)
- Funding allocations will mirror UK Govt award – annual allocations

Cronfeydd Galluogi / Enabling Funds

Aim to establish enabling funds for projects of less than £250,000

- **Community Regeneration Fund**
- **Supporting Local Business Fund**
- **Voluntary Sector Key Fund**
- **People and Skills Fund**

Syniadau ac awgrymiadau ar gyfer gwneud cais

Application hints and tips

- Use the word version
- Must show evidence of local need and support
- Fit with local strategies
- Fit with regional strategies – e.g. Wellbeing of Future Generations, Regional Skills Plan
- Must show the project contributes to a SPF intervention and objective
- Projects must contribute to SPF Outputs and Outcomes – noting the definitions and consider evidence that will support achievement.
- Delivery in more than one local authority area – expenditure and indicators per county
- Enable noticeable investment in the places people live, as well as support individuals and businesses – fostering local pride in place.
- Must be financially completed (all delivery activity concluded) by **31st December 2024**, and have realistic milestones
