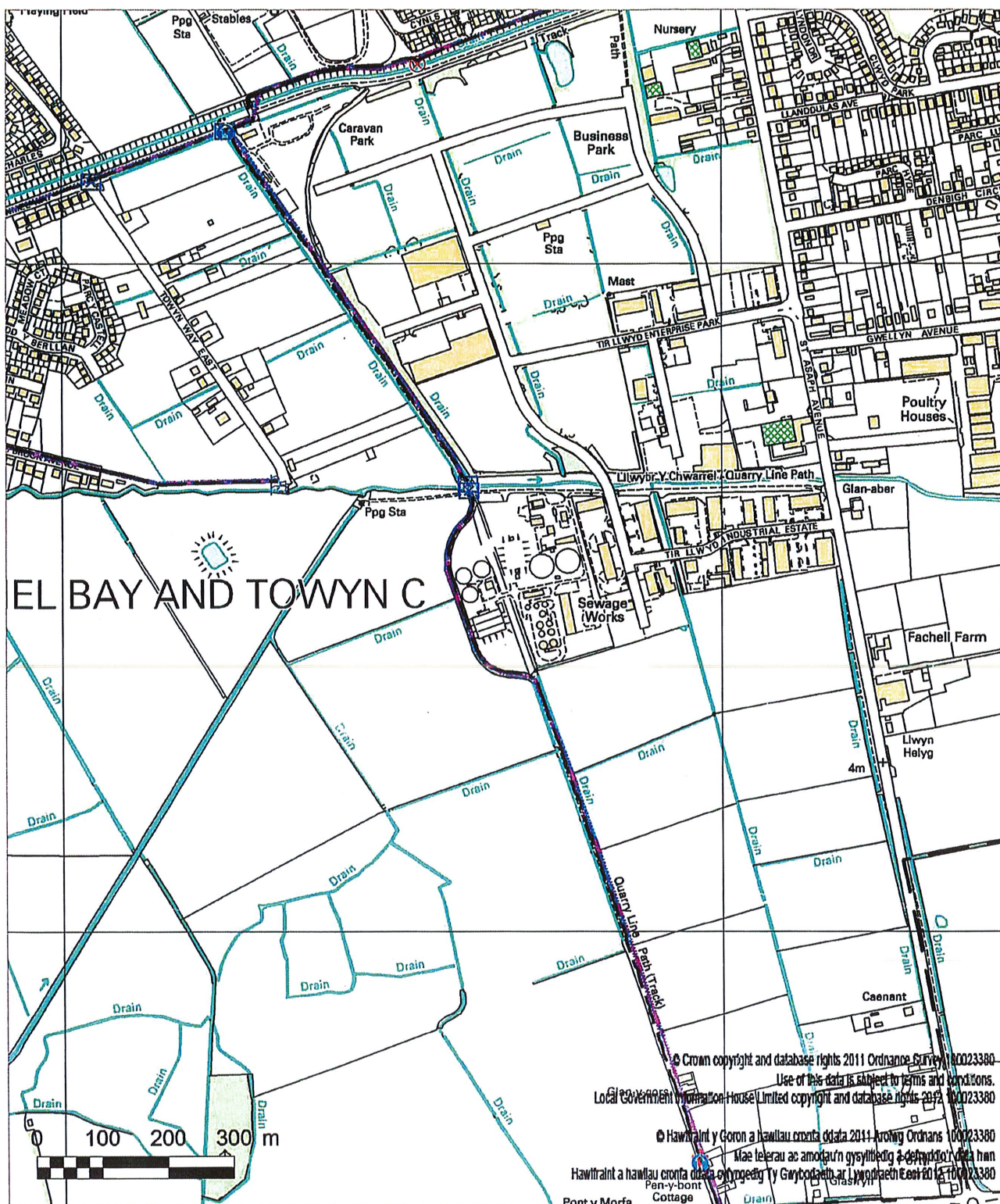

AGREEMENT FOR THE DELEGATION OF INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

Agreement

For their part the Community/Town Council agrees to :-

Make all reasonable effort to work towards restoring the Rights of Way network with regard to the less able, through the means available.

Not proceed with any maintenance works without prior approval from the Authority.

Carry out functions in accordance with the Authority's present policies and standards. The Authority shall advise on any amendments to these.

Acknowledge the Authority's and Community / Town Council's support on any promotional material.

Ensure that any contractors employed have public liability insurance to the sum of £5,000,000.

Payment

The Authority shall normally make available to the Community / Town Council in respect of identified works, up to a maximum of £1,500 for any one approved scheme and up to a total aggregate amount within a financial year of £4,000.

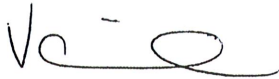
Community / Town Councils will be entitled to include all reasonable fees in respect of the costs of administration provided that the aggregate figure of £4,000 for the financial year is not exceeded.

The Authority reserves the right to withhold agreement to the carrying out of any works in the event that the available budget has been fully utilised. The Authority shall advise should this situation transpire.

The Community / Town Council **must** submit **all** invoices for works carried out by no later than **15th March** in each financial year. **Invoices not received by this date will not be paid.**

The Community Council shall indemnify the Authority against all action claims demands and liabilities arising from or in connection with the exercise or failure to exercise by the Community Council of the functions delegated by this Agreement.
