Dear Clerks,

In September 2024, we provided you with information on our 7 step process for assessing 20mph roads, following clarification from the Welsh Government of the 30mph speed limits guidance.

We have used the Place Criteria set out in the Welsh Government guidance to review 20mph A and B roads. We have now drawn up a priority list of the applicable road sections which we will be taking forwards for a full assessment.

These streets and road sections are:

1. **B5115:**

- B5115 from Brompton Avenue, Bae Colwyn (Colwyn Bay) through Llandudno Road, Bae Penrhyn (Penrhyn Bay)
- B5115 Colwyn Road, Llandudno to Conway Road, Llanrhos

2. **Bryn Lupus Road, Llanrhos**

3. **Rhos Promenade and Marine Drive, Llandrillo-yn-Rhos (Rhos on Sea)**

4. **Glan y Mor Road, Bae Penrhyn (Penrhyn Bay)**

5. **B5106:**

- B5106 from Gyffin through Tal y Bont
- B5106 Dolgarrog to Trefriw

6. **A547:**

- A547 Llanddulas Road, Abergele
- A547 Llysfaen Road, Hen Golwyn (Old Colwyn) to Abergele Road, Bae Colwyn (Colwyn Bay)
- A547 Conwy bridge

7. **A548:** Foryd Road and Towyn Road, Tywyn (Towyn) and Bae Cinmel (Kinnel Bay)

8. **B5383** Rotary Way, Hen Golwyn (Old Colwyn)

9. **St Asaph Avenue, Bae Cinmel (Kinnel Bay)**

10. **B5113:** Kings Drive to Llanrwst Road, Bryn y Maen

11. **B5279 Tyn y Groes Road**
12. **Meirion Drive, Conwy**
13. **B4406 Penmachno to A5**
14. **Conway Old Road to Bwlch Sychnant (Sychnant Pass)**
15. **Maesdu Avenue, Deganwy**

What happens next?

Step 4 Collect data and assess sites. The data will include traffic speeds and flows and also historical road traffic collisions.

Step 5 If the assessment suggests that a speed limit change could be considered, we will consult with local residents, local members, town/community councils and the emergency services for their views.

Step 6 If a proposal for a speed limit change is deemed acceptable, then a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) process will follow. You can find more information on the Traffic Regulation Order process on our website here: [What are Traffic Regulation Orders?](#)

Step 7 Implement speed limit signage changes (where and if applicable).

We will update you on the roads we intend to take forward to the Traffic Regulation Order process when we have completed Step 5.
