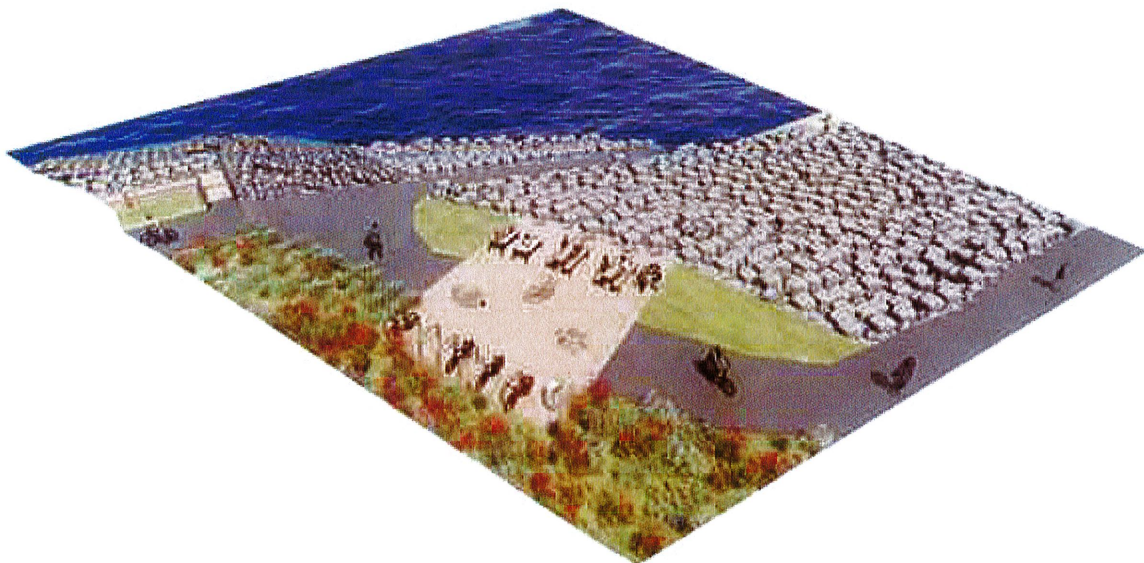

However in summary:

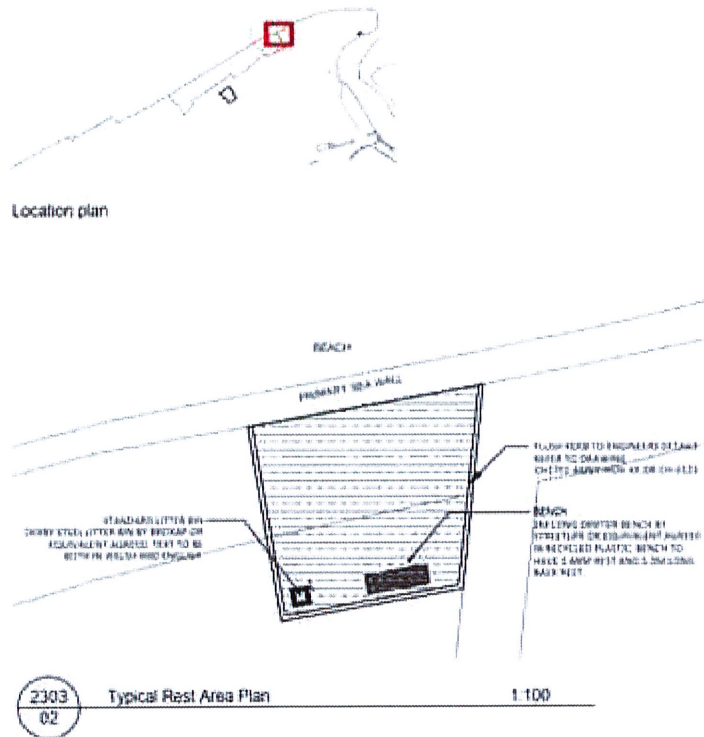
- **Towyn Parklet (west side of Golden sands Caravan Park)** – this includes 2no longer seats and 2no picnic sets



- **Sandy Cove to Beach Car park @ st Asaph Avenue - Coastal Path** – 4no bench seats at regular intervals adjacent to the existing coastal path . These seats are positioned at the rear of the coastal path (landside)
- **Sandy Cove to Beach Car park @ st Asaph Avenue - Replacement beach access step structures** – Some (2no) of the proposed replacement beach access step structures include benches/seats. These are located seaward of the seawall and appear to accommodate Cllr Griffiths request?
- **St Asaph Car Park** – Includes 3no picnic sets, 4no 2m long drifter bench seats



- **St Asaph car park to SunnyVale Caravan Park – rest area** – Includes 1no 2m long drifter bench seat



- **St Asaph car park to SunnyVale Caravan Park - Replacement beach access step structures** – Some (1no) of the proposed replacement beach access step structures include benches/seats. These are located seaward of the seawall and appear to accommodate Cllr Griffiths request?

Obviously we will take on board the request, and explore if additional benches can be included in the scheme. I can't make any promises at this stage, but rest assured the project team will take these suggestions on board very seriously. We will also look at our available budget and if the opportunity arises then we can consider including additional seating. This may/maynot be in the locations proposed in the attachment. If and when we are in a position to advise, we will revert back to yourselves and the local members as appropriate.
