Thanks for everyone's responses to our email sent on the 27th June regarding the Kinmel Bay Coastal Defence works.

SITE MEETING - KB BEACH CAR PARK.

As mentioned in the email on the 27th June, we have received a number of requests from councillors to look to include other additional works/upgrades/benefits as part of the scheme. Obviously we only have a finite budget as part of the scheme, but obviously we are keen to explore some of the suggestions so that as much wider benefits can be included as part of the scheme delivery.

Some of the suggestions have included:

1. Increased number of benches along the coastal path to provide more frequent areas to stop and relax/enjoy the views
2. Improved and upgraded access to the promenade from Roland Avenue
3. Improved and upgraded access to the promenade from Woodside Avenue
4. Improved and upgraded access to the promenade from Southlands Road (upgrade uneven path, improve access gate to at southlands road end of path, remove level difference where path meets promenade)
5. Improved and upgraded access to Baysville café from the promenade (to allow step free access for mobility scooters/wheelchair users etc)
6. Promenade lighting to the promenade
7. Raising the level of the promenade path to reduce the impact of the seawall raising.
8. Increased CCTV coverage

We will be available at the Kinmel Bay Beach Car Park on Tuesday 30th July @ 10.30am to discuss and look at the potential suggestions and any others that you may have. We will send out a separate calendar invite shortly.

If you have any additional suggestions that you wish to share between now and the site meeting, then please do not hesitate to share these for consideration.
