Good Afternoon,

Thanks for your below email where it's content has been noted.

Let me take this opportunity to thank you for your feedback regarding the proposal sent over on the 20th of August for Horton Nose Lane.

We will re-review the Parking Restriction proposal here, factoring in all your feedback and produce further options for you and Local Members to consider before proceeding with an Informal Consultation. We will aim to get to this point before the close of this working week.

I also note your request for us to review Clwyd Bank / Plas Bach, Kinmel Bay. I can see in our TRO folders here a draft proposal was drawn up for Clwyd Bank / Plas Bach back in 2023. I have attached the plan, have you seen this previously? What are your thoughts on the extents on this plan currently?

Regarding Cader Avenue, we are not aware of any ongoing issues here for the current TRO order in place or the lines on site. Has the Town Council received reports of further parking issues here? I have attached the latest TRO made for the area which included some additional extents on Cader Avenue from back in August 2020.

All matters in 15.b have been noted and passed on to our Maintenance Officer for the Area. When the desired restriction does go ahead here for all parties, it is hoped most of these issues will cease to exist. We however note your point on the lack of mobility access here for all users of our network, something we will consider along with the Parking Restriction to protect the existing crossing facilities and to review if further crossings are required.

With reference to your email of 20/08/2024 (copy below), the members at the Full Town Council meeting held on Monday 2/9/2024, fully discussed and considered the Proposed and Existing Parking Restrictions in the Towyn and Kinnel Bay area, and I append below an extract of the draft meeting minutes:

15. Proposed Parking Restrictions – Horton's Nose Lane

Resolved that: -

a) The Clerk writes to Conwy CBC with the following parking restriction suggestions:

- To consider introducing parking charges along Hortons Nose Lane
- To consider introducing day time parking restrictions for campervans

b) The Clerk writes to Conwy CBC to raise the following concerns regarding the location for the proposed parking restrictions at Horton's Nose Lane.

- Littering along the grass verge
- Smell of urine from some campervans
- Lack of disabled access on the pavement next to the parked campervans/vehicles
- Grass verge being used as a picnic/sitting area by the campervan owners

c) The Clerk writes to Conwy CBC asking them to consider installing double yellow lines on the junction of Clwyd Bank/Plas Bach (Kinnel Bay) to the farm gate as part of their parking restriction review in the Towyn and Kinnel Bay area, as there has been a number of road traffic accidents at this location.

d) The Clerk writes to Conwy CBC to request clarification regarding the existing parking restrictions/arrangements at Cader Avenue (Kinnel Bay).

- 1) **Acknowledge receipt of this email, and confirm the next stage/timings.**

And

- 2) **Clarify/confirm the existing parking restrictions/arrangements at Cader Avenue.**
